She is dreading the Christmas holidays as she says the cost of feeding her children puts her even more in debt with her bills. We are trying to pay for more families like this to receive a hot meal during the Christmas holidays when free school meals are not available so you can always bring us any toys, childrens warm clothes and desperate for warm coats for all ages as well as boots.
